WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All candidates must:

- ✓ be currently enrolled in, or considered a recent undergraduate or graduate student who has received a degree within the last semester
- ✓ be eligible to work in the U.S.
- ✓ be at least a sophomore at a 4-year college or university have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
